Terms

1. The Student Bursary Co-ordinator will receive applications and make recommendations to the Executive Committee. Specialists in the area of the applicant's research will be co-opted as necessary.
2. Applicants should be Members of the Society but, if not, then one year's membership of the Society shall be granted to the recipient of the Bursary.
3. The applicant shall submit a CV and a proposal of not more than 200 words identifying the subject area of the proposed research or research in hand. The research shall be for examination by dissertation or thesis.
4. The applicant shall specify the institution and course attended and the names of the Head of Department and Academic Supervisor who will be required to comment as referees on the applicant's suitability for the Bursary.
5. A report shall be submitted immediately following the Symposium. This will be included in the Society's Newsletter. The Society may publish the completed dissertation or thesis in *Costume*, the Journal of the Society and on our website, if appropriate.
